



Dixon County Board Minutes



DIXON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS – AUGUST 27, 2019

The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on August 27, 2019 at 9:00 A.M. for a special meeting in the Jury Room in the Dixon County Courthouse in Ponca, Nebraska. Vice Chair Neil Blohm opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and called for roll call of members present. Answering were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Greta Kraemer, and William Koch. Absent: Lisa Lunz. Also present was Cindy Purucker, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board and other interested persons. Vice Chair Blohm gave notice to the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Law.

Motion was made by Andersen, seconded by Koch to show that this meeting was preceded by due and legal notice by posting as required by law in the Bank of Dixon County, bulletin board in the lower hall of the courthouse, bulletin board in the County Clerk’s office and two County newspapers, and all Board Members were notified simultaneously and the agenda of all know business to come before the Board of Supervisors was posted in the office of the County Clerk. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Greta Kraemer, and William Koch. Absent: Lunz. Supervisors voting against: None.

After considering requests for preliminary levy allocations from Daily, Hooker and Clark Townships, Supervisor Kraemer moved for the adoption of a Resolution stating final levy allocation of levy authority of the County’s levy be approved at .00000 cents per one-hundred dollars of valuation for the Townships. Supervisor Andersen seconded the motion. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Greta Kraemer, and William Koch. Absent: Lunz. Supervisors voting against: None. Supervisor Koch moved for the adoption of Resolutions stating final levy allocation of levy authority of the County’s levy for a total amount of up to .122302 cents per one-hundred dollars of valuation of Dixon County’s total valuation be approved for the Dixon County Agricultural Society, Historical Society and Rural Fire Districts. In the event the subdivision is in a Mutual Finance Organization, and the levy for the MFO is set at a different amount, the Board gives authority to the subdivision to use the levy set by the MFO. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Kraemer. On roll call vote, Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Greta Kraemer, and William Koch. Absent: Lunz. Supervisors voting against: None.

The County budget was reviewed and discussed, and the County Clerk was directed to publish the Notice of Budget Hearing.

As new business Chair Blohm asked the Board to think about the possibility of getting a loader and using the New Holland tractor at the Ponca Shed to pile and load gravel instead of running the backhoe or payloader all the way from Allen.

There being no further business to come before the Board, motion to adjourn was made by Nicholson, seconded by Mackling. On roll call vote Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Greta Kraemer, and William Koch. Absent: Lunz. Supervisors voting against: None.

The Board adjourned at 9:45 A.M.
