## DIXON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCEEDINGS – JULY 28, 2020

The Dixon County Board of Supervisors met on July 28, 2020 at 9:00 A.M. for a special meeting at the Courthouse Annex, 59140 Highway 12, Ponca, Nebraska. Chairman Lisa Lunz led the Pledge of Allegiance, then called for roll call of members present. Answering were: Don Andersen, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, William Koch and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Also present was Cindy Purucker, Dixon County Clerk and Secretary to the Board. Chairman Lunz gave notice to the public of the location of the posted Open Meetings Law.

Motion was made by Andersen, seconded by Peterson to show that this meeting was preceded by due and legal notice by posting as required by law in the Bank of Dixon County, bulletin board in the lower hall of the courthouse, bulletin board in the County Clerk’s office and two County newspapers, and all Board Members were notified simultaneously and the agenda of all know business to come before the Board of Supervisors was posted in the office of the County Clerk. On roll call vote: Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, William Koch, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Supervisors voting against: None.

The ongoing road map project was discussed. Discussion was had on criteria for becoming a county road vs. township road. Some roads were added that were not in the plat book that were proved to be roads. Chair Lunz stated that she would like to have a meeting sometime in September with the townships to discuss road classifications.

Mowing of the roads was a topic of discussion. By statute landowners are responsible for the mowing of the roads adjacent to their property. It was stated that we should make a consistent policy on mowing the roads that follows statute. Tree removal and gating of roads was also discussed.

Chair Lunz will work on developing an interlocal agreement to share with the townships.

Sheriff Don Taylor, Sara Kumm and Shea Scollard, Emergency Manager were present to discuss the appointment of the 911 Coordinator. Job duties were examined and management items were reviewed. A motion to appoint Sara Kumm as 911 Coordinator was made by Koch, seconded by Mackling. On roll call vote: Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, William Koch, and Lisa Lunz. Absent: None. Supervisors voting against: None.

The Board talked over the budget funds that they are responsible for.

Supervisor Koch left the meeting at 11:28 A.M.

The hiring of a road foreman will be discussed at the September meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Board, motion to adjourn was made by Blohm and seconded by Mackling. On roll call vote: Motion carried. Supervisors voting in favor of said motion were: Don Anderson, Neil Blohm, Alan Mackling, Terry Nicholson, Roger Peterson, and Lisa Lunz. Supervisors voting against: None.
